Travel halfway around the globe and you are greeted with the New World Savy B that bursts of tropical aromatics & fruit with herbaceous and green bell pepper notes. No one does it better than New Zealand. Expect a crisp & aromatic White Wine no matter the region.

Wonderful freshness on the nose with hints of green apple & ripe apricots. Rich on the palate with a lingering citrusy finish.

**2020** Ramon Bilbao / Rueda, Spain 115 | 550 Verdejo

Subtle hints of lime, fennel and grapefruit with discerning acidity. A crunchier version of a Savy B!

2020 Enrico Serafino | Gavi di Gavi DOCG / 165 | 800 Piedmont, Italy Cortese

Truly the hidden gem of Piedmont, a region-known for bold Reds. Gavi di Gavi greets you with red apple, floral & citric notes at the start and a dry minerality for the finish.

#### 2021 Pasqua | Passione Bianco IGT / 135 | 650 Veneto, Italy Garganega

Intense tropical & peach flavours on the nose and a buttery texture on the palate. The grapes are dried to create a concentrated flavour and a fuller body. This is one of a kind!

**2019** Kaiken / Mendoza, Argentina 580 Torrontes

Rose petals on the nose and lemon peel on the palate. The pale yellow wine is long on the finish and exhibits dry acidity.

2021 Fritz Haag | Juffer Kabinet / 850 Mosel, Germany Riesling

Lush, round & semi sweet on the palate with a hint of tanginess. Fine expression of minerality & floral that is synonymous with Blue slate soil of Mosel.

Could Abruzzo be the new Tuscany? The last decade of Montepulciano wines certainly lead us to think so. Where else would you be greeted by ripe red cherries, silky tannins and subtle minerality all at once?

Mencia (men-thee-uh) is quickly developing a cult following thanks to its versatile drinkability. The Pinot Noir meets Cabernet Franc varietal exhibits abundant red cherry notes & light spice on he nose & tongue & putting spotlight back on the long overlooked region of Bierzo. Could it be the next big thing after Tempranillo? We believe so!

Alentejano, Portugal Touriga Nacional, Syrah, Alicante Bouschet & Petit Verdot

The 'Tinto' is all the proof you need to bust the myth that Portugal only makes good port wines. Touriga Nacional & Alicante Bouschet bring a rich mouthfeel of toasted milk and caramel on the palate while Syrah lends subtle notes of cacao, spice and tobacco. This is worth exploring!

### The DOCGfathers

DOCG is the highest classification in Italy's wine appellation system. Short for Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita, DOCG was introduced in 1980 with the Barolo & Barbaresco as the the first to receive DOCG stamps followed by Brunello di Montalcino, Amarone della Valpolicella & others over the course of the next decade.

#### 2018 Château Haut Piquat / St Emilion, France

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc

A richly aged and well balanced wine with purple fruit from Merlot & herbal notes from Cabernet Sauvignon. One of the most revered Crus from the right bank of Bordeaux.

Dolcetto might mean the little sweet one but this wine is far from its literal translation. The black grape varietal showcases dark ink fruit, licorice and spice with a medium body finish. If you love wines from Peidmont like we do, then this is one to try.

Colchagua Valley, Chile Cabernet Sauvignon & Carmenere

We might be put to the gauntlet for saying this but Chile might be a curve ahead of France when it comes to the more accessible Cabernet Sauvignons. The Bordeaux style Cabernet Sauvignon from the Chilean valleys are light & fresh with notes of tobacco & nutmeg and rich cherries.



### The Allure of GSM

The complex & age worthy blend of Grenache, Shiraz & Mourvedre. Châteauneuf du Pape champions the GSM blend in Southern Rhone where Grenache tends to be the most dominant grape and provides soft, spiced berry flavors and a round mouthfeel. Syrah brings out a wild side to the blend with aromas of smoked meat, black pepper while Mourvèdre adds earth tones and gamy flavors with high amounts of color pigment and tannin.
