

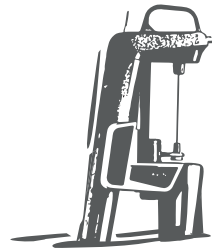

Bordeaux Sauvignon Blancs are renowned for expressing the terroir - strong minerality and racy acidity with lush notes of honeydew and gooseberry. Blending with Semillon adds a balance to the acidity with a more rounded finish. Travel halfway around the globe and you are greeted with the New World Savy B that bursts of tropical aromatics & fruit with herbaceous and green bell pepper notes. No one does it better than New Zealand. Expect a crisp & aromatic White Wine no matter the region.

*Intense tropical & peach flavours on the nose and a buttery texture
on the palate. The grapes are dried to create a concentrated flavour

*Rose petals on the nose and lemon peel on the palate. The pale
yellow wine is long on the finish and exhibits dry acidity.*

Could it be the next big thing after Tempranillo? We believe so!

The DOCGfathers

DOCG is the highest classification in Italy’s wine appellation system. Short for Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita, DOCG was introduced in 1980 with the Barolo & Barbaresco as the the first to receive DOCG stamps followed by Brunello di Montalcino, Amarone della Valpolicella & others over the course of the next decade.

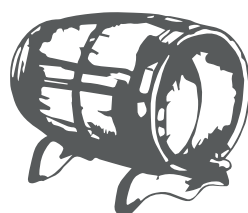
*A richly aged and well balanced wine with purple fruit from Merlot

light & fresh with notes of tobacco & nutmeg and rich cherries.*



The Allure of GSM

The complex & age worthy blend of Grenache, Shiraz & Mourvedre. Châteauneuf du Pape champions the GSM blend in Southern Rhone where Grenache tends to be the most dominant grape and provides soft, spiced berry flavors and a round mouthfeel. Syrah brings out a wild side to the blend with aromas of smoked meat, black pepper while Mourvèdre adds earth tones and gamy flavors with high amounts of color pigment and tannin.
