

*The 'Tinto' is all the proof you need to bust the myth that Portugal only makes good port wines. Touriga Nacional & Alicante Bouschet bring a rich mouthfeel of toasted milk and caramel on the palate while Syrah lends subtle notes of cacao, spice and tobacco. This is worth exploring!*

DOCG is the highest classification in Italy's wine appellation system. Short for Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita, DOCG was introduced in 1980 with Barolo & Barbaresco as the first to receive DOCG stamps followed by Brunello di Montalcino, Amarone della Valpolicella & others over the course of the next decade.

### *The Allure of GSM*

The complex & age worthy blend of Grenache, Shiraz & Mouvèdre. Châteauneuf du Pape champions the GSM blend in Southern Rhône where Grenache tends to be most dominant grape and provides soft, spiced berry flavors and a round mouthfeel. Syrah brings out a wild side to the blend with aromas of smoked meat, black pepper while Mouvèdre adds earth tones and gamy flavors with high amounts of color pigment and tannin.
